

Dear Sir/Madame

Thank you for your letter of 9 March 2021, advising us of the Cities intention and plans for parking in a greater surrounding area for city workers.

The map has caused some discussion in our Parish Council. There are serious ramifications which could arise as a result of the action you propose. Please note our thoughts as follows;

- Many of the street in this area are very narrow and not suited to parking or should be limited to one side only.
- Like in the city, the first two hours should be free. This would allow for an event to take place and the participants can then depart within the time allowed.
- Difficulty for householders who don't have parking on their household site. If friends or relative visit they have to park on the street side and may end up on the grass berm.
- While we do have parking on the St Andrew's property, a large funeral or wedding will fill it up and cars need to park elsewhere. Your plan will make this extremely difficult if not impossible.

It is thought therefore, that Te Aroha Street from River Rd to Claude lands is not a good choice for permanent parking.

We hope these thoughts will help in your considerations.
